

An old creaking door slowly open and the light comes through the darkness, sounds of laughs arriving from far away, a secret world awakes.... what is it? An old store full of frippery, furniture, cloths, cymbals and brass, crazy and funny beings locked up since too many years inside that 'bazaar'.

"*Gran Paniko Al Bazaar*" is a melting show of circus, clown, theatre and live music.





Paris, 17th February 1673, Jean-Baptise Poquelin (also known as Molier) plays the main part in 'The Imaginary Invalid'. In the middle of the show he bursts into a suffocating cough that makes his performance more convincing. Several hours after the show he dies. Neville Tranter – inspired by this anecdote – created a show about one of the most outstanding actors and playwrights. This is a performance dealing with a man, standing between his unwavering faith in the great ideals and an attempt to fit into the difficulties of everyday life. Molier wanted to utterly sacrifice himself for art, but too many factors were against it: lack of money, poor actors, spoiled wife, fragile health and 'important persons' better to be avoided. Molier always dreamt of spectacular roles, but because of his speech defect he was condemned to comic characters. He alone, the master, was capable of making a life tragedy wear a comic costume.
